Meaning and Interpretation

Parbat Uthaate Huye..."***

In Jatipura, Krishna is shown lifting Govardhan Parbat, the legendary act where he protected the villagers from Indra's wrath. This shows Krishna's divine power and his role as protector.

Vaishnavjan Mein Dekha
